COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic in Wilson County

You must have an appointment to receive a vaccine. Walk-ins will not be accepted.

Who is eligible to receive a vaccine?

Individuals who are part of the Phase 1A, Phase 1B, or Phase 1C group qualify to receive a vaccine. Individuals who work in a school or daycare setting also qualify to receive a vaccine. If you register to receive a COVID-19 vaccine at a DSHS clinic, you are attesting that you meet the criteria to be included in either Phase 1A, 1B, 1C groups, or you work in a school or daycare setting.

You are **<u>not</u>** eligible to receive a **Moderna** COVID-19 vaccine if:

- You are younger than 18 years old
- You are not part of the Phase 1A, Phase 1B, Phase 1C groups, or you do not work in a school or daycare setting
- You have symptoms of COVID-19 on the day of the clinic
- You have been diagnosed with COVID-19 within 10 days of the clinic
- You have a history of severe allergic reaction (e.g., anaphylaxis) to a previous dose or component of the COVID-19 vaccine product
- You have received passive antibody therapy as treatment for COVID-19 within the last 90 days
- You have received another vaccine within 14 days of the clinic

What should I do on the day of the clinic?

If you have registered for an appointment:

- Bring a face mask to wear at the clinic
- Arrive no more than 15 minutes early for your appointment
